Responsibilities:

Define and agree compliance calendar, Support plants on OSHAS complaints, Develop and implement health and safety plans, data capture and ongoing analysis, Set up and implement hazardous waste, wastewater or toxin management programs, Oversee and review health and safety documentation and data, Coordinate safety and environmental audits and actions to remedy faults and remediate and Consult with all departments to provide expertise and ensure compliance with standards, processes and permits.

Job Description:

To create and enforce a culture of safety within our organization and jointly implement programs, policies, and assessments to ensure H&C is in compliance with all federal and internal health and safety regulations. They may also review reports and findings to monitor performance and detect trends related to health and safety. The candidate should be familiar with the following regulatory programs such as PPE, Electrical Safety, Lockout/Tag out, Machine Guarding, Forklift, Hazard Communication and other programs as the need arises.

Roles and responsibilities include:

- Assist on incident investigations and corrective actions
- Conduct job hazard analysis, and recommend preventative/corrective action where EH&S hazards exist.
- Train employees on EH&S programs.
- Maintain EH&S records.
- Performs administrative duties for the EHS department including but not limited to general data entry and filing of training records, compliance documentation, and other EH&S records

- Develop and support implementation of various safety policies and programs.
- Manage Hazardous Waste (WAA, profiles, and coordinate disposal)
